No contact temperature checks and a quick set of questions will ensure our team is ready, willing and able to provide safe dental care.



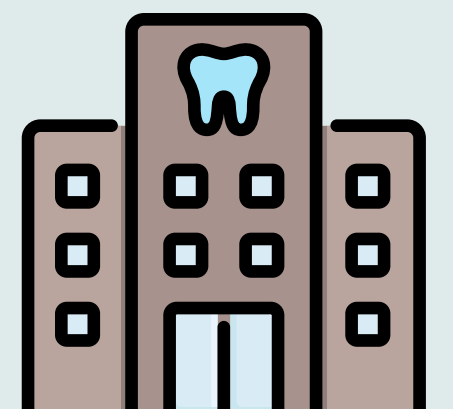
No Handshakes or Hugs

In order to minimize cross-contamination, we ask that you please dispose of any outside gloves before entering.



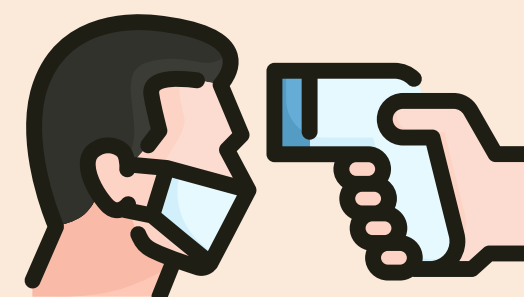
Updated Patient Scheduling

Helpful signs and markings will be in effect to maintain 6 feet at all times.

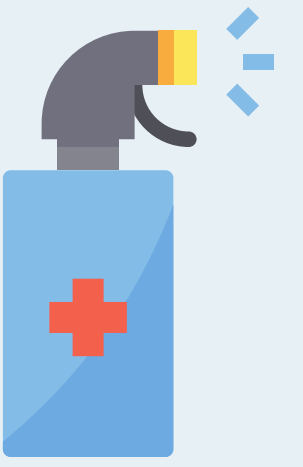

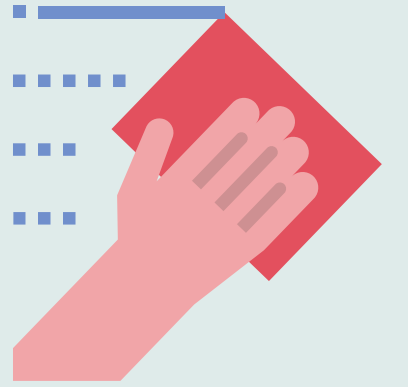
Sterilization After Every Appointment

We have strict sterilization standards as we thoroughly wipe, sanitize, and disinfect all instruments, equipment and surfaces in each treatment room after every patient.



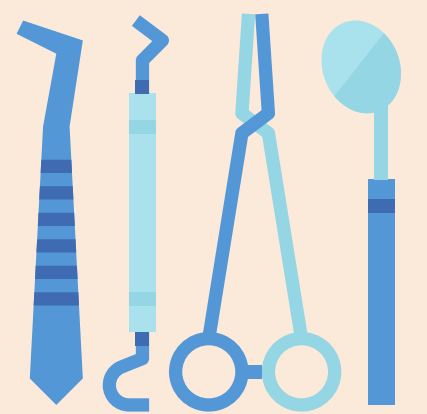
Deep Cleaning Every Evening

In addition to our thorough sterilization between patients during the day, we go one step further with a total disinfection after hours.



CDC-Approved Instrument Sterilization

This has been standard procedure at all times and nothing has changed. Anything that goes near your mouth is disposable, heat or pressure cleaned between every use.



N95 & Level 3 Masks

Our dental team – dentists, hygienists, assistants and front desk staff – will be protected at all times. We are smiling underneath!



Face Shields

Our clinical team will also protect you and themselves through the use of FDA approved face shields.



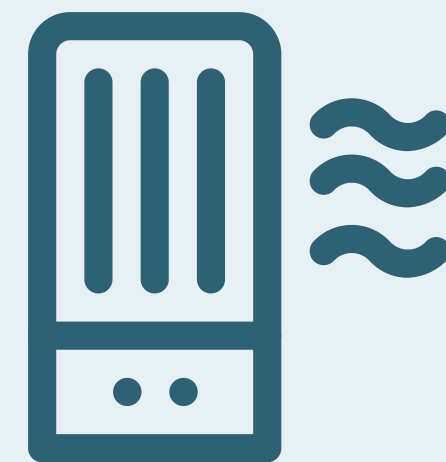
Advanced Chairside Suction

Whenever possible, we will activate high speed evacuation to minimize aerosol contamination and improve air quality.



Air Filtration

Our air has never been cleaner. We are using medical grade H13 True HEPA filter to remove 99.97% of particles you don't want around.

Installed Clear Front Desk Barriers

Hard plastic guards have been placed strategically around the front desk counters to help block movement of airborne particles.
